## Opening of a new maintenance facility for Motoyama alliance partner in Saudi Arabia

Motoyama concluded Business Alliance Agreement on March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2013 with Kubota Saudi Arabia Company, LLC(KSACO) in order to strengthen sales and maintenance services in GCC countries, i.e. the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, Kingdom of Bahrain, Kuwait, the Sultanate of Oman, Qatar and the United Arab Emirates. KSACO was established in DAMMAM by Kubota Corporation and a Saudi Arabia investment company, Tharawat Development Company in 2009, as a manufacturer and a supplier of cracking tubes used in petrochemical plants.

After concluding the Alliance Agreement, KSACO expanded their facilities in order to start valve maintenance business and then, held a shop tour inviting local users on March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Shop area is around 2,400 m<sup>2</sup>. In the maintenance shop, it is divided by valve maintenance space for Kubota valve and Motoyama control valves and safety relief valves. Necessary tools and equipment have been arranged according to suggestions of Motoyama. An Invitation was sent to local end users and 4 users participated the shop tour. Every users put their expectations on maintenance service capability of KSACO.

This is the 5<sup>th</sup> authorized maintenance shop following to Singapore, Taiwan, Indonesia and Malaysia. Motoyama continues to search for new maintenance facilities in other countries.
