Due to the Tohoku-Kanto Earthquake occurred on March 11th, 2011, our factory, some family members of our employees and their houses have been suffered from the disaster.

We are sorry to cause you any inconvenience to this and also we appreciate very much having many encouraging phone calls and e-mails. We sincerely apologize for not answering to those message sufficiently due to massive blackout of Ohira and our employees' living area and restriction of telephone lines.

Fortunately, we declare that none of our employees in Ohira works were injured or damaged from the earthquake.

On March 14th, some employees came to Ohira works and checked status of our office and workshop. However, still electricity had not been recovered at the time, we closed our factory after finished the checkup.

On March 15th, the electricity has been restored so that telephone, facsimile and other network started in operation.

From yesterday, re-organizing work in our office, checking the situation of all the facilities in our factory and establishment of recovery plan have been undertaken. Further, we have been reviewing if our products were suffered from the earthquake and establishing an expected production schedule for ordered items.

Knowing the situation of suffered area, especially in coast side in Tohoku region, by press every day, more we recognize how big the earthquake was.

We anticipate it takes little time for complete restoration. However, we will make every effort, having many encouragement from customers or business partners, to recover from this disaster, taking every care on safety and health of all the employees.
